Tuesday, March 16th, 2021 at 7 PM Beyond DDT: Pesticides, Pollinators, and **Population Declines**

Presented by: Erin Parker, Field Conservation Officer and Nature Centers Manager, Detroit **Zoological Society**

Peregrine falcons, once extirpated from states East of the Mississippi River, now routinely rear young in downtown Detroit. Bald Eagles, Ospreys, and many other birds of prey species have seen dramatic population increases since the banning of the insecticide DDT (dichloro-diphenyltrichloroethane) across Europe and the United States in the early 1970s.

But many other groups of birds are currently seeing steep populations declines- is there a link to pesticide use? What can homeowners, community members, and lawn maintainers do to conserve birds, bats, and the 'bugs' that feed them all? How do biomagnification and bioaccumulation work (and, um, what do those terms mean, anyway?) We'll look at the research on chemicals in the environment and discuss how to support healthy backyard ecosystems so that we can all thrive together.
